Plenary ready to open up 'spiritual conversations' with members with nation-wide meetings ready to start

WHEN Australia's plenary council assembly opens on Sunday it will be different to any other plenary meeting before it. It will be the country's fifth plenary event – the last was held in 1937, an exclusively male gathering, with only bishops, theologians and superiors of male religious orders attending.

The 2021 Plenary assembly will include women, religious and lay people among 280 members drawn from Catholic communities across the country.

The plenary will also be the first held virtually, as a necessary pandemic precaution.

"There have been moments when <u>we wondered if we'd ever make it to this point</u>, but led by the Holy Spirit and supported by a cast of thousands across the country, we're within touching distance," Plenary Council facilitator Lana Turvey-Collins, said.

A key component of the Plenary Council assembly will be the way members consider the 16 questions that make up the Council agenda.

Each day, some of those questions will be the focus of small group discernment, with about 10 members engaging in what is known as "spiritual conversations".

"One of the most important conversations in the Gospels is between the Angel Gabriel and Mary in the Annunciation. That conversation is the very model of the steps in discernment," Jesuit Brother Br Ian Cribb, who spoke about discernment during the Brisbane Assembly in 2019 – a lead up event for the Plenary Council – said.

"We work from the premise that the Spirit of God is at work in the world, in the Church, in our mission and in every person."

PARISH COVID-19 UPDATE & EVENTBRITE BOOKING SYSTEM

The following restrictions are in place here at St. Joseph's Parish during this time:

A. Government Regulation:

All parishioners must sign in through the QLD Check-in App

- B. Archdiocesan policy—Ticketed seating all parishioners must receive a seat number from the marshals. 100% capacity for ticketed when allocating seating when permitted. Ticketed seating means a person is given a ticket with their seat number on it and will remain (as much as possible) in their allocated seat while at the place of worship. This also means we need your name and contact details for Parish records, to record the number of your seat -
 - C. PLEASE continue to use the Eventbrite Mass booking system:

- D. Masks must be worn in indoor or outdoor spaces if you are closer than 1 person per 2 square metres.
