In the book of Daniel, Daniel has a vision of 'one like the son of man' who is presented to God. This son of man receives 'dominion and glory and kingdom' (Dan 7:14). This is the glory James and John request to participate in by attaining privileged seats in the kingdom. They have not understood that Jesus will be glorified by God the Father because He has served others and will give 'his life as a ransom for many' (Mark 10:45).

Jesus is the head of the Church, and we are the body; as Jesus has served, so must we serve. As Jesus has given himself for the eternal life of many, so must we, but always in union with Jesus.

The Greek word for service, 'diakonia' has several connotations. It can mean charitable service, which can be either private or Church authorised. Diakonia can also mean spiritual service, especially in connection with ordination, but not exclusively. Jesus is establishing what the Church would come to understand as corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

Corporal works of mercy include feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, sheltering the homeless, visiting the sick, visiting prisoners, burying the dead and giving alms to the poor. Spiritual works of mercy include counselling the doubtful, instructing the ignorant, admonishing the sinner, comforting the sorrowful, forgiving injuries, bearing wrongs patiently, and praying for the living and the dead.

Today's Gospel reminds us that we are all called to serve the Church, whether the domestic church – the family, or the wider Church community. We all have a 'diakonia' to fulfil, a service to perform. We are also called to 'ransom' others through our personal sacrifices made in union with Jesus. *Adrian Eldridge*

# PARISH COVID-19 UPDATE & EVENTBRITE BOOKING SYSTEM

The following restrictions are in place here at St. Joseph's Parish during this time:

A. Government Regulation:

All parishioners must sign in through the QLD Check-in App

- B. Archdiocesan policy—Ticketed seating all parishioners must receive a seat number from the marshals. 100% capacity for ticketed when allocating seating when permitted. Ticketed seating means a person is given a ticket with their seat number on it and will remain (as much as possible) in their allocated seat while at the place of worship. This also means we need your name and contact details for Parish records, to record the number of your seat -
  - C. PLEASE continue to use the Eventbrite Mass booking system:

- D. Masks must be worn in indoor or outdoor spaces if you are closer than 1 person per 2 square metres.
- E. Clergy and readers who are socially distanced from others may remove their mask while speaking and then put the mask back on.
- F. Parishioners may remove their masks momentarily for reception of Holy Communion.
  - G. The choir and cantors are required to wear a mask at all times.
