Feasts of remembrance – All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day

First of November is marked annually in the Catholic liturgical calendar as a day to remember and venerate saints from around the world and throughout history not only those known and canonised, but also all unknown as well.



In the 4th century, All Saints' Day traditions served to honour the great number of individuals martyred for their faith during the persecutions in the late Roman Empire. It was during the 8th century that Pope Gregory III declared that all saints be remembered on November 1.

All Saints' Day is an opportune time to consider the example saints offer us today and to reflect on how we can imitate their holiness. As Pope Benedict XVI remarked in 2011, All Saints' Day calls us "to see the Church... as Christ wanted it, that is, as the communion of saints".

All Souls' Day follows All Saints' Day on November 2, when Catholics remember, pray and offer Mass for the souls in Purgatory, that they may be purified and attain the Beatific Vision." All Souls Day annually provides Catholics a chance to pray and do Christian works in memory of the dead, but in reality every day presents a fine opportunity to do so.



PARISH COVID-19 UPDATE & EVENTBRITE BOOKING SYSTEM

The following restrictions are in place here at St. Joseph's Parish during this time: A. Government Regulation:

All parishioners must sign in through the QLD Check-in App

B. Archdiocesan policy—Ticketed seating - all parishioners must receive a seat number from the marshals. 100% capacity for ticketed when allocating seating when permitted. Ticketed seating means a person is given a ticket with their seat number on it and will remain (as much as possible) in their allocated seat while at the place of worship. This also means we need your name and contact details for Parish records, to record the number of your seat -

D. Masks must be worn in indoor or outdoor spaces if you are closer than 1 person per 2 square metres.

G. The choir and cantors are required to wear a mask at all times.
