## **COVID VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS**

The Archdiocese of Brisbane is committed to protecting our employees, contractors, volunteers and those they serve. As Queensland's borders will open in coming weeks we are preparing for increased risk of COVID-19 infection in the community. Queensland Health continues to urge people to get vaccinated and reminds us that vaccination is the most effective way to lessen the risk of exposure or the risk of passing the virus on to others.



Therefore, the Archdiocese has made the decision that all employees, and contractors will need to have received two doses of a COVID-19 vaccination by 15 December. Some specific volunteer roles will also require vaccination. You can view the Archdiocesan Vaccination policy here and FAQs here.

Volunteers who are required to be vaccinated under this policy include those individuals who deliver or undertake activities:

- with children and vulnerable adults
- in homes, in workplaces, and hospitals and health care settings working with any person (this is not limited to children and vulnerable adults only)

Volunteers do not have to be vaccinated under this policy where that position is solely related to activities that are purely domestic, social, recreational, religious, or private in nature, including Mass.

Typical volunteer roles that will require vaccination include:

- ♦ Administration work in parish office
- ♦ Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion who attend to the sick in hospitals or private residence
- ♦ Hospital Chaplains
- ♦ Outreach Homeless Support including children
- ♦ Safeguarding Local Officer
- ♦ Youth Co-ordinator
- Ministries involving children such as: Catechists, Leaders of Children's Liturgy of the Word, Sacramental Coordinators and Altar Server Coordinators

#### PARISH COVID-19 UPDATE & EVENTBRITE BOOKING SYSTEM

The following restrictions are in place here at St. Joseph's Parish during this time:

A. Government Regulation:

All parishioners must sign in through the QLD Check-in App

B. Archdiocesan policy—Ticketed seating - all parishioners must receive a seat number from the marshals. 100% capacity for ticketed when allocating seating when permitted. Ticketed seating means a person is given a ticket with their seat number on it and will remain (as much as possible) in their allocated seat while at the place of worship. This also means we need your name and contact details for Parish records, to record the number of your seat -C. PLEASE continue to use the **Eventbrite Mass booking system:**

- If you have been in an impacted of locked down area in the last 14 days, you must continue to wear a mask until 14 days have passed (nb: there are currently no impacted areas in Queensland).

# Archbishop Mark has a message for you

At this late stage in my life I find myself wishing at times that I'd known some things earlier in life that I've come to learn only in recent years. I had this feeling the other day when I spoke at length with a woman who has spent years working with and accompanying people who were sexually abused in their early life. She spoke to me about trauma and even of what she called complex trauma. I found myself thinking, "I wish I'd known this years ago when I first met victims and survivors of abuse". For years I heard the word "trauma" but I had only a very vague sense of what it meant. I'm not sure that I fully understand trauma even now, but I know a lot more about it than I once did; and I certainly understand more of what it means to say that our response to abuse has to be trauma-informed. Trauma, and especially complex trauma, is a very mysterious thing, but its effects are undeniable and devastating, often lasting through a lifetime. An understanding of trauma and its effects helps to explain otherwise baffling behaviour, and it helps us to respond in ways that build a sense of trust and safety. So for me as a pastor it's a matter of better to learn late than never.
