As most of you will know by now, I am leaving St Joseph's parish after four and a half years of ministry here. My wife Jeanette and I moved down to Woody Point (near Redcliffe) back in June after living in Caloundra for the past twenty-six years. We wanted to 'downsize' our accommodation and to be closer to our children and grandchildren. It was not an easy decision, and has not been an easy move but times change and it is for the best as they say. Besides, Woody Point is a beautiful place.


I met with Bishop Ken Howell (Director of the Deacons) and with the Priest-in-Charge of Redcliffe parish Fr Bob Harwood and both were happy to recommend me to be appointed to that parish. Archbishop Mark Coleridge has now officially appointed me as Deacon there from 1st January 2022. I have also been re-appointed to the ministry of 'Christian Marriage Formation' in the archdiocese.

It has been a privilege and honour to have journeyed with you all, and I will miss all of you as individual people and as a parish community. I have connected with many of you, as much as possible, and I have appreciated the love and support shown to me. Every parish has its own uniqueness, but when I first arrived in Nambour back in 2017 I was struck immediately by the number of people involved in ministries across the parish, and by the strong sense of hospitality. I continue to appreciate and value your ongoing commitment.

Father Graham Gatehouse was kind enough to welcome me into the parish back in mid-2017, and he and I formed a very positive working relationship. I was happy to welcome and support Father Odinaka on his arrival in the parish in January of this year. His appointment was literally a cultural change for the parish. Father Odinaka and I also developed a positive and respectful relationship, and I thank him for the respect shown towards me personally and towards my ministry as a deacon. I pray that you will continue to support him in his role as parish priest in whatever way you can. You are very fortunate to have such a fine young man in this parish.

St Joseph's parish is also fortunate to have another permanent deacon, with Adrian Eldridge's recent appointment. He is not replacing me as such; new permanent deacons tend to be appointed to their home parishes. Deacon Adrian will bring his own strengths and abilities to his ministry within the parish, and I also ask that you support him as much as possible.

I am excited to be appointed to Redcliffe parish, as there will be new opportunities for me as a deacon and my ministry there will be somewhat different to St Joseph's. I ask that you keep me in your prayers as I will keep you all in mine. I wish everyone a happy and holy Christmas, and a blessed 2022.

I'm sitting in a doctor's waiting room after having my Pfizer booster which I did as soon as I could, not least because the Omicron strain is upon us. So much has gone wrong in Australia and around the world. I end the year with the feeling that I've been dealing with one crisis after another. But Christmas is always Christmas; and I think of Leonard Cohen's words: "Even though it all went wrong, I'll stand before the Lord of song with nothing on my tongue but Hallelujah". It's not quite the angels' song but it's where I am as I look back across this year and ahead to the one that's coming.

PARISH COVID-19 UPDATE & EVENTBRITE BOOKING SYSTEM

The following restrictions are in place here at St. Joseph's Parish during this time: A. Government Regulation:

All parishioners must sign in through the QLD Check-in App

B. Archdiocesan policy—Ticketed seating - all parishioners must receive a seat number from the marshals. 100% capacity for ticketed when allocating seating when permitted. Ticketed seating means a person is given a ticket with their seat number on it and will remain (as much as possible) in their allocated seat while at the place of worship. This also means we need your name and contact details for Parish records, to record the number of your seat -

- From 1:00am 18 December, 2021 face masks will be required in Queensland when you are at ٠ indoor shops and retail centres, visiting hospitals, disability accommodation services and residential aged care facilities, on public transport, on taxis and ride shares, at an airport, on a plane, or if you have COVID symptoms.
