That is the way I can hope to take my place in the resurrection of the dead." —Philippians 3:10-11 In two weeks' time, we will celebrate Jesus' Resurrection from the dead. To share in His Resurrection, we must "share in His sufferings by being formed into the pattern of His death" (Phil 3:10). **"You can depend on this: If we have died with Him we shall also live with Him" (2 Tm 2:11).** The cross is the only way to resurrection from the dead.

On Palm Sunday and Good Friday, we will read the Passion of Christ. On Good Friday, we will venerate the cross and the wounds of Christ. Many of us will pray the Stations of the Cross in these last days of Lent. The Lord works through these "Passion-prayers" to communicate His crucified love for us. Then, impelled by this love, we take up our daily crosses, redemptively suffer with Jesus, and are crucified with Him. Dying to ourselves, we will rise to live in the Lord's love forever.


Unfortunately, the human instinct and desire naturally want a life of maximum pleasure and minimum pain. We want to stay in our comfort zones. As we enter more deeply into Jesus' Passion and death, the Lord is calling us to a life of maximum holiness and minimum selfishness. The Lord is calling us out of our comfort zones of sin and into the "love zone" at the foot of the cross. By God's grace, let us make the way of the cross our way of life.

Laetare Sunday brought us the joyful message of reconciliation. Now as we move closer to Easter, we are given another image of Salvation, an additional invitation to joy. The story of the woman caught in adultery is breathtakingly apposite: it addresses the sin and tendency to judgement in all of us, using the emotive issues of sexuality and marriage. On the surface, there appear to be only one sin involved in the story – the sin of adultery. But when we look deeper we see that there are other sins present – the dreadful sin of using this woman as a bait to entrap Jesus, and the malicious sin of hatred towards Jesus. Jesus' handling of the situation is radical and innovatory. Instead of justice and condemnation, he introduces mercy and compassion, turning attention away from self-righteousness to inner assessment and humility in the face of our human weakness. Jesus in fact shows us the way beyond justice, the way of mercy and utter forgiveness.


