Holy Eucharist Enrolment

St Joseph's Parish invites parents to another wonderful opportunity to contact the parish office to enrol their children in year 5 into this year's sacramental program for Holy Eucharist before.

For families who will be enrolled in this Sacramental Program for this year, our first 'compulsory' Parents' Information Session will hold on Thursday April 28th; and the second Parents' Information session (for those unable to attend the first session) will hold on Thursday May 5th, both begins at 7pm, at the Ryan Room. In each of these sessions, preparation process will be outlined and questions answered.

On Sunday morning, the **12th of June**, there is a mini retreat that brings the preparation to an end and the Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated.

On Saturday, June 18th at the 6pm Mass, and on Sunday June 19th (Feast of Corpus Christi), at the 8am Mass, the sacrament of Holy Eucharist will be celebrated for the children who have successfully completed their preparation process.


