Divine Mercy Sunday – Year C – Reflection

There are two times in the Church's calendar where a liturgical feast is celebrated for eight days and ends in a liturgical feast.

The first occurs at the Christmas Octave, where we celebrate the Solemnity of the Nativity of Christ on Christmas day and end with the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. There is a clear connection between the birth of Jesus, God made flesh, and Mary the Mother of God.

The second occurrence of a liturgical octave is at Easter. At this octave we celebrate the Solemnity of the Resurrection of Christ on Easter Sunday. On the Second Sunday of Easter we celebrate the Feast of The Divine Mercy. Sacrosanctum Concilium states, "dying, He destroyed our death, and rising He restored our life" (SC 5 §2). This is the act of great mercy Jesus shows us. The death and resurrection of Christ flow out of His great love and mercy for us.

The love that Jesus has for all of humanity is so great that throughout history Jesus has felt the need to remind people that His love is stronger than death and that His mercy is limitless. The Feast of Divine Mercy is a special occasion reminding us of this.

Jesus revealed to a Polish nun, St Faustina Kowalska, His infinite love for all of humanity. He asked her to spread devotion to His Divine Mercy. In 2000 Pope St. John Paul II instituted the Feast of Divine Mercy in response to our Lord's requests. We are asked to trust in the mercy of Jesus, to venerate His Sacred image and to pray for mercy of all those in need, whether spiritual or physical. We are called to imitate the mercy of Jesus to others in practical ways as well.

Please join in our local parish celebration of this feast day after the 8am Mass on Sunday 24th April 2022 at 9:15am.


