John 21: 1 - 19

Encounter with the Risen Christ

Peter and his fishing companions, Andrew, John and James, were initially called by Jesus to follow Him after they had experienced a fruitless night of fishing at the start of Jesus' three-year ministry. Jesus instructs them to let down their nets again, resulting in a miraculous catch of fish (Mark 1:17). The miraculous catch of fish is repeated in today's Gospel when the risen Jesus calls out to the fishermen.

The scene in John's Gospel is intensely Eucharistic; Jesus provides His disciples with food, He is feeding them at the shore of the Sea of Galilee – near the same location where He worked two miraculous feedings with fish and bread.

John presents us with a movement through this section of his Gospel: The disciples are not able to achieve anything without Jesus, Jesus calls to the disciples who respond, Jesus feeds His disciples, Jesus forgives His disciples (Peter), then He commissions His disciples (again represented by Peter) to announce the Gospel and to feed all of the followers of Jesus.

We can see ourselves in this passage. Like the disciples, we cannot achieve anything worthwhile without Jesus. Like the disciples, Jesus is calling each one of us, giving us instructions and commandments, we are feed by Jesus at every celebration of the Mass – we are nourished by the Word of God read in Sacred Scripture; we are feed with the Word made flesh in the Holy Eucharist. We are commissioned to proclaim the Gospel through word and how we live our lives.

In the Eucharist, Jesus tells each one of us, "I love you." Like Peter, Jesus asks each one of us, "Do you love me?" In the coming week, are we able to find ways of saying to Jesus, "Yes, I love you?"; through times of prayer, paying visits to the Blessed Sacrament, and in the way in which we treat those we meet throughout the course of the week.


