Easter Week 4 Year C: John 10: 27 - 30

This weekend, we welcome children who will start preparing for their reception of First Holy Communion. This is a special time in their faith formation as they learn to appreciate the real Prescence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. The children will journey through a five-week program that will culminate in their receiving Holy Communion on the Feast of Corpus Christi.

During this Easter season it is important that we all prepare to encounter the risen Christ. As Catholics, we are especially privileged to encounter the risen Christ in the Eucharist.

We can prepare to meet Jesus in the Eucharist by having a daily prayer life. It is not a case of how much we pray, but that we pray sincerely. Other spiritual exercises, such as, a regular examination of conscience, being attentive at Mass, quietening our hearts before Mass begins, through prayer, and listening carefully to the Scripture readings, can all help prepare us to meet Jesus in the Eucharist.

As we process forward to the Eucharist, we make an act of reverence, by bowing or genuflecting, to the Eucharistic Jesus. To receive Jesus in the hand, as requested by our Archbishop, we can follow the advice attributed to St. Cyril of Jerusalem, "..... make your left hand a throne for the right, as for that which is to receive a King. And having hollowed your palm, receive the Body of Christ, saying over it, Amen. So then after having carefully hallowed your eyes by the touch of the Holy Body, partake of it; giving heed lest you lose any portion thereof; for whatever you lose, is evidently a loss to you as it were from one of your own members. For tell me, if any one gave you grains of gold, would you not hold them with all carefulness, being on your guard against losing any of them, and suffering loss? Will you not then much more carefully keep watch, that not a crumb fall from you of what is more precious than gold and precious stones?" Immediately consume the Sacred Host before returning to your seat.

This is an opportunity for all of us to consider how best to prepare to receive Holy Communion. Please keep the children in your prayers that they might prepare well for their First Holy Communion.




