

Inner Peace in Divine Love, Nambour QLD -Jesuit and Ignatian Spirituality Australia A Four Week Retreat in Daily Life

This First Spiritual Exercises retreat runs over four weeks in daily life. It guides you in prayer and reflection for 30mins each day. The retreat is for anyone who desires to grow in their relationship with God.



and is based on the Spiritual Exercises by St Ignatius of Lovola. This retreat is a way of encountering the Creator as Love in your everyday life through a program of personal prayer and attending a weekly gathering of guided spiritual conversation – online or in person.

On Saturday September 3rd, at 3pm, we celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation for the children who have successfully completed their preparation process.
