Luke 12:49 - 53: I have come to bring fire to the earth

The fire Jesus longs to bring upon the earth is different to the destroying fire Elijah called down as recounted in 2 Kings 1:9 - 11. The fire that Jesus longs to see upon the earth is the Holy Spirit. Jesus links the coming of the Holy Spirit with His passion on the cross. The cross is the baptism that is causing Him much distress. The Holy Spirit does indeed come at Pentecost, filling the Apostles with the courage to bear witness to Jesus. The Holy Spirit also fills them with heavenly wisdom, enabling them to preach Jesus to their fellow Jews and then to the ends of the earth.


Currently, twelve children in our parish are preparing to receive the Holy Spirit. They will receive the Holy Spirit in a new way at their Confirmation. During their preparation for Confirmation, the children have been reflecting on their baptism. In baptism, they have been buried and raised with Jesus and have become a new creation in Christ.

The children have also reflected on how they are called by name to serve God, like the saints and like the famous people in the Bible readings we share each Sunday. This week the children have been learning about the gifts of the Holy Spirit. These gifts will enable them to bear witness to Christ with their lives; the gifts of knowledge, fortitude, counsel, piety, fear, understanding and wisdom.

Empowered with these gifts, they are called to bear fruit for the kingdom of God. The fruit of gentleness, faithfulness, self-control, patience, kindness, joy, generosity, peace and love. These are the fruits of the Holy Spirit and a life spent in a close relationship with God.

As a faith community, we can support the children through our prayers, through our use of the gifts of the Holy Spirit we received at our own Confirmation, demonstrating how to use these gifts in everyday life, and by our witness to Jesus.

We can all reflect on the personal meaning Confirmation holds for us. Do we bear witness to Christ in the life situations Jesus has placed us? Please continue to pray for the children preparing for Confirmation. Please offer the children your support and encouragement. Deacon Adrian Eldridge

2022 SAFEGUARDING TRAINING LEVEL 1 & LEVEL 2

Dear Parish Volunteers,

Thank you for your ongoing commitment to supporting our Parish community in the various ministries. St Joseph's Safeguarding audit 2022 is scheduled for 18th August.



It has been 3 years since we have undertaken the Level 1 safeguarding training required of all volunteers with parishes in the Brisbane Archdiocese. This training is now due for renewal by all volunteers prior to 1st September 2022.

Option one: Online using a computer

Option two: Join in a 1 hour volunteer training session in the Parish Ryan Room on Monday 22nd August at 11:00am.

Please email or phone the Parish office to register your preferred option for the training session.

Certain volunteers need also to complete the higher level of safeguarding training, Level 2, (e.g. roles which involve access to church keys/codes and/or roles involved with children or aged care visitation etc). Please refer to the volunteer, matrix which is available in the office and has been emailed, to check your ministry requirements.


training as Safeguarding training that is not properly registered with the People & Culture (HR) Office in Brisbane will not be recognised for compliance.
