## Luke 18:1 - 8: Persist in Prayer

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that we can understand Sacred Scripture in two *senses*, the literal sense and the spiritual (CCC115). Regarding the literal sense, St Thomas Aquinas writes, "All other senses of Sacred Scripture are based on the literal" (Summa Theologiae 1, 10, ad 1). This can be challenging for modern readers, especially when we read of battles being fought, such as, in our first reading this week, "With the edge of the sword Joshua cut down Amalek and his people" (Ex 17:13). We have to remember that battles have been fought throughout history and are being fought still today; a sad consequence of original sin.

St Paul in our second reading reminds us that "All Scripture is inspired by God and can profitably be used for teaching, for refuting error, for guiding people's lives and teaching them to be holy" (Tim 3:16). He also gives us a key for interpreting Scripture, by keeping to "what you have been taught" and to "remember who your teachers were" (Tim 3:14). The apostles were taught by Christ, they in turn taught the first generation of Christians and the Apostolic Fathers. These in their turn taught the early Doctors of the Church. The teachings were handed down through the generations forming a "golden chain" of teaching. The tradition, starting in the time of Christ and expressed by St Paul and the early Church Fathers was to give both the literal meaning of Scripture and the spiritual.

The battle fought against Amalek and his people can be seen as a real ancient battle between the people of Israel and a pagan people determined to annihilate Israel. It can also be seen as a spiritual battle for ourselves against the spiritual powers that would like to destroy us. Like Moses, as long as we continue to pray, we can win the battle. The weapons we use to fight are the Sacraments, the Holy Rosary, fasting and prayer, remembering that the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the greatest of all prayers.

Jesus, in this week's Gospel, reassures us that God always hears our prayers. God hears us and will give an answer to our prayers, even if He should not respond as quickly as we would like (I still want God to work on Adrian time and not on His time!) We, however, must pray with faith, and persistently, crying out to Him, "day and night" (Lk 18:7).
