IT'S CHRISTMAS, LET US BE REJOICE!

The modern world still has many mysteries. This time of year we need to write to Santa and tell him of what we hope to receive from him for Christmas. The rest of what happens is still very mysterious.

I have often wondered how Santa can deliver all those presents in just one night. As an international airline pilot I have had the pleasure to fly people to be with their families for Christmas. I have operated several flights over the years that have departed on Christmas Eve, sharing the sky with Santa. We always keep a good eye out for him.

All airline pilots lookout for Santa if they are operating on Christmas Eve. Often we wear Christmas ties and hats with our uniform to remind us that it is Christmas so we don't forget. We don't want to fly too close to Santa because of our jet engines. The jet blast could make Santa's sleigh wobble and some toys could fall out. That would be really disappointing to a child who would not know why Santa did not have any presents for them. They might think they have been bad, when they hadn't been, which would be very upsetting. All children deserve joy at Christmas.

But it's difficult to know where Santa is. Santa does not conform to modern air traffic control systems. He doesn't have a radio to talk to controllers and we never know what flight level he is going to be at. Also his sleigh is invisible to Radar so we can't see him on our screens. All we can do is put our aircraft lights on to bright so he can see us and look carefully in the sky for Rudolf's red shiny nose. Rudolf's very shiny nose is the only thing visible in the black night. I have been told that's the only way to see Santa. And it doesn't help that we can't hear the sleigh bells because of the noise of our loud jet engines.


One year we were taking off from London late on Christmas Eve flying back to Australia. It was very cold and had been snowing. We wore our Christmas hats and ties. The Captain went to say hello to some of the families with young children who were our passengers waiting to get on the plane. We were all glad that we had people to share Christmas with.

When we got into the sky we were pleased that there was a bright moon which would make it easier to see if Santa was near us. Whilst the crew were getting dinner ready the First Officer had a good idea to make a passenger announcement from the flight deck asking the boys and girls to look out the window and keep an eye out for Santa because Santa could be flying by in the next few minutes. It proved to be a great idea.

Within 5 minutes there was a very loud joyful cry from a young boy who had seen Santa. "It's Saaannntaaa!" He was very excited and pointed it out to his younger sister who also saw him. They were full of joy. It was only a brief sighting and by the time the adults came to look Santa had gone on his way. But all the same it was a joyful sighting and gave plenty of Christmas cheer to all. Wherever you are at Christmas may you receive company and joy in abundance. Mark has a message for you

Recently I've done a series of podcasts on some of the remarkable characters who fill the Bible. Each of them is immediately identifiable as human. because the Bible cuts down to size anyone who has heroic pretensions. God is the only hero in the Scripture, and everyone else is as flawed and unheroic as human beings tend to be. But these are human beings drawn into the unfolding of God's extraordinary plan not just for humanity but for the cosmos. This is the God who ultimately becomes human when the Child is born in Bethlehem. So in the biblical characters the divine and the human interweave, so that in reading human stories you discover the divine and in reading the divine story you discover the truly human as we do in these podcasts. The story of these human beings is also my story and yours. That's why in meeting them we meet the deeper truth of ourselves...and the deeper truth of who God is in our life.
