CALL FOR ENROLMENT - THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE (RECONCILIATION) FOR CHILDREN

Through the sacraments of Christian Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist, we are made members of God's family, and receives the gift of the Holy Spirit. We also become members of the Church, the Body of Christ. However, we're always in a situation of rift with God, with ourselves and our neighbours. Our human deficiency and inclination to sin always pushes us to fall away from that first innocence of our Baptism.

When our relationship with God and the community of the Church is broken, when we are separated from the fellowship of the table of the Eucharist, we need the sacrament of Penance. In the sacrament of reconciliation, we hear and respond to God's call to conversion. God's grace and mercy brings about in us a change of heart. We are led to recognise our sin and experience true contrition. So we make our confession and express our sorrow to God; God's forgiveness makes us decide to live our lives according to the Gospel.

The family is central to the faith formation of their children, and as parents, you are your child's primary teachers as he/she develops a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church. Conversely, the Church/parish is responsible for establishing and running programs for sacramental preparation and for the celebration of the sacraments.

St. Joseph Parish's enrolment process for the Sacrament of Reconciliation for those in grade 6 and above will begin soon, starting with the Parents' Information Night. Below are the scheduled date and Time for preparation sessions:

ON THE BURIAL OF A POPE

Why Are Popes Buried With Red Chasubles?

The Chasuble which is red, a liturgical colour symbolizes a willingness to shed one's blood for the faith, is the colour vestments popes traditionally are buried in

Where Are The Popes Buried?

Popes are buried under the Basilica. There are about 91 popes buried in St. Peter's Basilica, including the beloved John Paul II who was buried there in 2005. As you walk around the church, you will see some of the most monumental ones in the various niches along the corridors. As time passed, it has been impossible to house all of the popes above ground, so they began housing them below ground in what is called the Papal tombs or crypt.

Benedict XVI will be buried in the Vatican Grottoes, underneath St. Peter's Basilica, the traditional resting place of popes, in the place where his predecessor was buried before being moved for beautification.

Why Buried with Red Shoes?

While each pontiff has had his own style, red shoes are a papal tradition that goes back centuries; red shoes are as ancient as the Church. Many Popes were even buried with red shoes: Paul VI, John Paul I, and John Paul II, etc.

Pope Benedict XVI stepped away from his red shoes the moment he resigned from the papacy and won't be buried with the red shoes. Far from a fashion statement, in the Catholic faith, red symbolizes martyrdom and the Passion of Christ. Red symbolized both the worldly authority of the pope and the Passion of Christ. It also symbolized the Pope's submission to Christ, the love of God for humanity, and the remembrance of all the martyrs who gave their lives for Christ.
