On Friday, June 9th, there is a mini retreat that brings the preparation to an end and the Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated. The retreat commences at 7pm, at the Church.

On Sunday June 11th (Feast of Corpus Christi), at the 8am Mass, the sacrament of Holy Eucharist will be celebrated for the children who have successfully completed their preparation process. The celebration concludes with a parish/family picnic at the Good Samaritan convent.
