Sunday Reflection

Moses received the Law from God at mount Sinai, and presented it to the people of Israel. When Israel received the Law and entered into a covenant with God, they became His people. The people of God consisted of twelve tribes descended from the twelve sons of Jacob. When Israel entered into this new covenant with God, all of the tribes were priestly tribes. They were to be a people set apart from other nations, a holy people who would eventually lead all the other nations to God.

While Moses was away from the people for forty days up a mountain in the presence of God, Israel rebelled against God. The tribe of Levi, Moses' own tribe, remained loyal to God, winning for themselves the role of the priestly tribe. However, the injunction to be a Holy people remained upon all the tribes, upon each person.

Jesus sees the people of his day without a shepherd. They are eagerly waiting for the promised leader to show them the ways of God. Jesus commissions the twelve Apostles to be shepherds of a new people of God. A new people comprised not only of Israel, but of all the nations. This new people would be royal, prophetic, and priestly. Royal, for Christ our leader is the son of David, King of Israel; He is also the King of heaven; Prophetic, for Christ is the prophet promised by Moses; Priestly, for Christ is the true High Priest. In Baptism, the minister anoints the person saying the words, "As Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet, and King, so may you live always as a member of his body, sharing everlasting life." The original vocation of Israel, to be a priestly people, is now given to the Church.

Only an Ordained priest has the authority and grace to consecrate the bread and wine transubstantiating them into the body and blood of Christ. The priesthood of the laity is exercised through praising and worshipping God as a people, making the sacrifices of corporal and spiritual works of charity, loving God and loving neighbour, making reparation for our own sins and those of others through acts of self-denial, and being a light to other people.

The Bishops of the Catholic Church are the successors of the Apostles with the mandate to continue to call the nations into the people of God. We work with our Bishops to become a holy people and to draw others to God through our witness and good example.
