CONFIRMATION ENROLMENT

Sacraments are sacred events, in which we enter more fully into the mysteries of our Catholic faith. They are community events, which remind us of the role of the community in our faith life.

Our parish Children's Sacramental Program for 2023 Confirmation starts next month, so here is another wonderful opportunity for parents to contact the parish office to enrol their children in year 4 into this year's program.



On Thursday 13 July or Thursday 20 July, parents are to attend either of the compulsory Parents Information Session, at 7pm, at the Ryan Room. In this session, preparation process will be outlined and questions answered.

Each weekend commencing from the weekend of July 29/30 to August 19/20, children who have successfully enrolled in the Sacramental Program are to attend Mass and either the Saturday or Sunday workbook review sessions.

On Friday night, the **25th of August, at 7pm**, there is a mini retreat that brings the preparation to an end and the Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated.

On Saturday August 26th, during the 6pm Mass, Bishop Tim Norton will celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation for the children who have successfully completed their preparation process.
