When Solomon first ascended the throne of Israel, he knew he lacked the experience and skill to be a king; but he knew who could give him the grace to rule wisely. The gift of understanding, mentioned in the first reading for this weekend, is sometimes translated as wisdom. It is only God who can bestow this gift.

Spiritual gifts are to be valued more than gold, the Psalmist sings. Gold is a precious metal highly prized in society. In heaven, though, it is the material the pavement is constructed from (Rev 21:21). How many people spend their lives ignoring true treasure and collecting pavement! To focus our attention on our spiritual lives is to seek the greatest treasure. Our relationship with God and our place in the Kingdom of God are *the* authentic treasures; they are the pearl of great value which we should sell all we have to acquire.

The children from the parish started their sacramental journey towards Confirmation last weekend. Please keep them in your prayers that they may receive all of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and that they may value the treasure of faith and the pearl of God's Kingdom above all other things.

Such a simple way, we can make a difference in our outreach - to support the needs of others.


