The gift of understanding, mentioned in the first reading for this weekend, is sometimes translated as wisdom. It is only God who can bestow this gift.

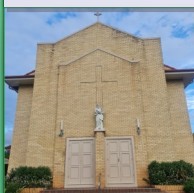

Our relationship with God and our place in the Kingdom of God are *the* authentic treasures; they are the pearl of great value which we should sell all we have to acquire.
