Feasts of remembrance - All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day

1st of November is marked annually in the Catholic liturgical calendar as a day to remember and venerate saints from around the world and throughout history - not only those known and canonised, but also all unknown as well.

In the 4th century, **All Saints' Day** traditions served to honour the great number of individuals martyred for their faith during the persecutions in the late Roman Empire. It was during the 8th century that Pope Gregory III declared that all saints be remembered on November 1.

All Saints' Day is an opportune time to consider the example saints offer us today and to reflect on how we can imitate their holiness. As Pope Benedict XVI remarked in 2011, All Saints' Day calls us "to see the Church... as Christ wanted it, that is, as the communion of saints".

All Souls' Day follows All Saints' Day on November 2nd, when Catholics remember, pray and offer Mass for the souls in Purgatory, that they may be purified and attain the "Beatific Vision." All Souls Day annually provides Catholics a chance to pray and do Christian works in memory of the dead, but in reality every day presents a fine opportunity to do so.

While no longer Holy Days of Obligation in Australia, All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day mark two very special celebrations for Catholics. Our parish will be marking these days with the celebration of the Holy Eucharist. Mass times this year for both of these special celebrations are: 6.30pm Liturgy of the Word on Tuesday, 31st, 10am and 6pm Masses on Wednesday, All Saints Day, and 8am on Thursday, All Souls Day.

This month we focus our prayerful intentions upon our deceased loved ones, family, friends, past parishioners and all who have died especially those who have no one to pray for them. Mass intentions for the dead will be offered daily throughout the month of November; and Mass envelopes are available at the entrance of the church. 
Guest Speaker: Snr. Constable Marty Hunt - will address personal safety, home security, road safety and other related issues in our local community.

exhort or encourage people to pray: we have to teach them how. The apostles asked Jesus to teach them to pray, and we need it even more than they did. Jesus taught them to pray, and in the end he's only one who can teach us to pray – chiefly by drawing us into his own prayer. We need to be taught to pray because sin is like a stroke. After a stroke, people have to re-learn the most basic skills of life, like how to speak. Prayer is the most natural thing of all for the human being, but because of the stroke of sin we need to relearn how to pray. Christian prayer begins not with speaking but with listening to the voice of Jesus; speaking comes only after that.

Therefore, we need to learn how to listen, and that's not easy in such a noisy culture. It means we have to learn to be still and silent, and that's not easy either. But it can be taught and learnt; and over time the rewards of that teaching and learning are remarkable. We see the world and everything in it differently. We even see God.


