King Solomon was renowned as a great exorcist during his lifetime. For centuries afterwards, people would exorcise demons “in the name of Solomon’s God.” Jesus breaks from this tradition, he does not rely on this well used and successful formula. He does not need to use a name with which to command authority over the demons. He only has to say the word and they have to obey Him. This would certainly have caught the attention of those witnessing such an event.

This incident was preceded by a teaching that was also filled with authority. The authority of Jesus is so noticeable that the people comment on how it differs from the authority of the scribes and the learned. The fact that Jesus taught with authority implies that the scribes did not teach with authority. Moses had instructed the people that there would be a prophet raised up by God, one who would have the words of God in his mouth. He instructs them to listen to this prophet.

The people of Capernaum reflect on what they have witnessed. There is a teaching with authority, there is an exorcism with authority, what can it all mean? Could this be the prophet? The people are right in stating “here is [something] new”. God is doing something new.

The God of all creation is exercising His authority over creation, for the benefit of people made in His image. The first words Jesus speaks in Mark’s Gospel are, “The time has come the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe the Good News” (Mark 1:15). To repent is to turn away from the power of evil and embrace God’s mercy and teaching; It is to live a new life. Jesus helps us in this new life. When we open our hearts to Jesus He teaches us with authority, He rebukes what is evil in our lives, He sets us free from all that prevents us from drawing close to God.
