The Call to Holiness: Embracing Our Mission

“All Christians are called to pursue holiness,” said Saint Pope JP II. “Holiness, the Pope emphasized, is a task that requires Christians to imitate Christ, not an option. It is a fundamental part of the Catholic faith.”

The readings today invite us to reflect on the universal call to holiness and our mission as Disciples of Christ. From the prophet Isaiah in the First Reading (Isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8), we hear the Isaiah's dramatic call to serve God's people. Isaiah is overwhelmed by the majesty of God's presence and recognizes his own sinfulness. Yet, he is purified and empowered to become a messenger of God's Word.

St. Luke, in the Gospel (Luke 5:1-11), gives us an account of the event of calling of the early three disciples - Peter, James, and John. Jesus performs a miraculous catch of fish, demonstrating his power and authority. Simon Peter, humbled by his own inadequacy, falls to his knees and begs Jesus to depart from him. Yet, Jesus reassures him, saying, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching people."

In the Second Reading from 1 Corinthians (1 Corinthians 15:1-11), St. Paul reminds us of the central importance of the Resurrection in our Christian faith, emphasising that Christ's Resurrection is the foundation of our hope and the guarantee of our own resurrection.

As we reflect on these readings, we are reminded that our call to holiness is intimately linked with our mission as Disciples of Christ. We are called to be messengers of God's word, to share the Good News with others, and to bring people to Christ.

Simon Peter's humble recognition of his own inadequacy is a powerful reminder of our own need for humility. We, like Simon Peter, are called to acknowledge our own limitations and to trust in Christ's power and authority.

As we journey through the ups and downs of life, we are reminded that Christ's Resurrection is the foundation of our hope. We are called to trust in the promise of eternal life and to allow Christ's light to illuminate our path.

May we, like Isaiah and Simon Peter, be open to the call to holiness and the mission that Christ has entrusted to us. May we be purified, empowered, and guided by his presence in our lives. And may we always remember that, with Christ, we are never alone, but always accompanied by the power of the Resurrection.

ARCHDIOCESAN SAFEGUARDING AUDIT

THANK YOU to all St Joseph's Parish volunteers for your involvement and contribution to one or more of the Parish Ministries you are involved in. You are all ever so amazing.

This year St Joseph's Parish has been assigned a 'Self assessment Safeguarding audit' which is currently being prepared and submitted online. In addition, this year, many volunteers at St Joseph's, registered on the Parish compliancy sheets, and according to your Ministry roles on the Archdiocesan Safeguarding matrix, and your renewal date, will automatically receive emails from the Archdiocese to renew online, Police checks and/or Blue cards (every 3 years), . Many volunteers are also due for renewal of Archdiocesan *Safeguarding training* (every 2 years), and revise and sign the *Safe conduct standards* form (every 3years). For people unable to complete online we will be hosting two in house training sessions, dates to be announced. We are happy to help you if you require any assistance in your online or hardcopy renewals.
